



UN Volunteer Specialist Programme for Korean nationals

The UN Volunteer Specialist Programme for Korean nationals is financed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Korea and implemented by the United Nations Volunteers (UNV) programme. This initiative provides professionals with the opportunity to offer their services to developing countries for a 12- to 24-month period, and to impact on development results on the ground. Participants share their knowledge and skills, broaden peer networks and gain international exposure and experience within the United Nations system.

Prerequisites

Only Korean nationals who have not yet served as a UN Volunteer Specialist funded by the Government of Korea are eligible to apply. Former UN Youth Volunteers and UN University Volunteers are eligible to apply.

Minimum requirements: 27 years of age at the time of application, university degree as stipulated in the respective Description of Assignment, three years of relevant professional experience.

Selection process

Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted. The selection will be done by the UN Host Entity at the level of the country of assignment. Interviews are envisaged to be conducted by the UN Host Entity between 23 January and 10 February 2023. Usually these interviews are competency-based.

How to apply

Candidates may apply to a maximum of three assignments and indicate the order of preference in the 'Additional remarks' field when filling in the application form.
