



UN Youth Volunteer Programme for Korean nationals

The UN Youth Volunteer Programme for Korean nationals is financed by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Korea and implemented by the United Nations Volunteers (UNV) programme. This initiative provides university graduates with the opportunity to offer their services to developing countries for a 12- to 18-month period, and to impact on development results on the ground. Participants gain new skills and grow at the professional and personal level; they strengthen their professional expertise, broaden peer networks and gain international exposure and experience within the United Nations system.

The [United Nations Volunteers \(UNV\) programme](#) provides global citizens with an opportunity to volunteer across the three pillars of the United Nations system: development; peace and security; and human rights. Prerequisites

Only Korean nationals who have not yet served as a UN Youth Volunteer or UN Volunteer Specialist funded by the Government of Korea are eligible to apply. Former UN University Volunteers are eligible.

Candidates must be between 22 and 29 years of age at the time of application.

Minimum requirements: Bachelor's degree (or equivalent), demonstrated interest and/or experience (up to three years) in the areas stipulated in the respective Description of Assignment.

Selection process

Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted. The selection will be done by the UN Host Entity at the level of the country of assignment. Competency-based interviews will be conducted by the UN Host Entity in February 2024.

How to apply

Candidates may apply to a maximum of three assignments and indicate the order of preference in the 'Additional remarks' field when filling in the application form.
